About the Crystal Rodríguez Memorial Scholarships

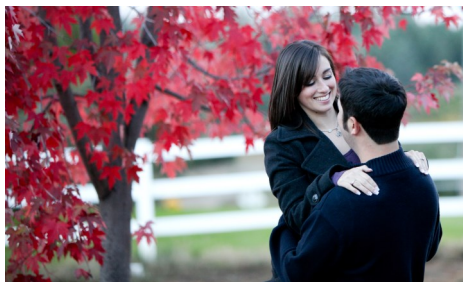

These partial scholarships are given out in remembrance of Victor M. Rodríguez's wife who died unexpectedly in an accident at the age of 22 on June 16, 2011.
